The pre-sale voucher costs \$35.95 in total



TSIC needs to sell 3,000 pre-sale license plate vouchers in order for the plate to go into production



You will receive your plate once we sell 3,000 vouchers



All sales go through the Escambia County Tax Collector (no matter the county you reside)

STEP 1:Click the following link https://govhub.com/fl-escambia/fl-escambia/vouchers

STEP 2: Scroll down to "Take Stock In Children"

STEP 3: Click the Purchase button & enter the license plate number of the vehicle you are purchasing a voucher

STEP 4: Click PAY NOW button

STEP 5: Complete the checkout for payment. \$33 for voucher + \$2.95 convenience fee = \$35.95

STEP 6: You will receive an email from PaymentExpress Escambia County Tax Collector after checkout

STEP 7: Follow the instructions provided in the email you will receive to complete your pre-sale voucher purchase

Please remember, you are purchasing a pre-sale voucher for the Mentoring license plate, not renewing your current plate. Thanks for your support of Take Stock in Children.
